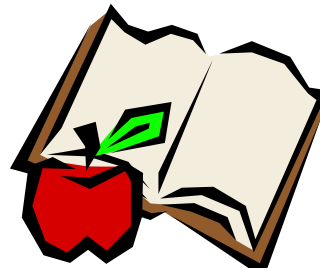
Did Adam and Eve actually eat fruit, or is the saying a parable?

The only source of information [we have about this] is the Bible narrative and it contains no intimation that it is to be interpreted other than literally. Some theologians believe the fruit is a symbol of temptation. It was described as "good for food" and

"pleasant to the eyes"- and it was within reach. Adam and Eve gave in and the consequences of their actions were far-reaching. Eating fruit is not a sin, but the fact they consciously and willfully disobeyed God certainly is. They were punished for their disobedience. Even if we should hold that it took some other form other than the literal eating of fruit, the principle is the same. The lesson here is *man's disobedience led to his destruction.*

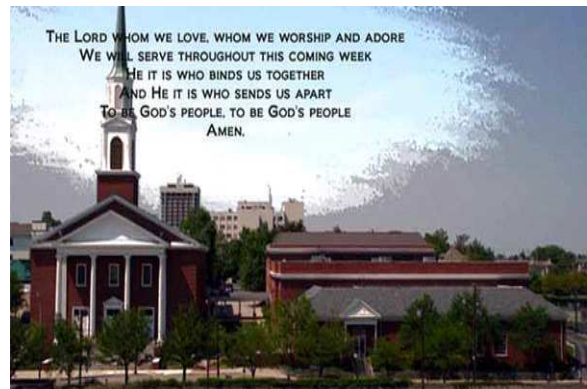

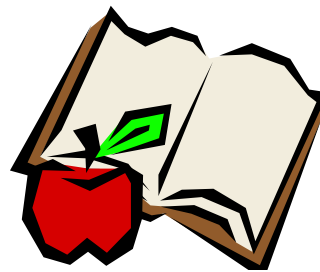

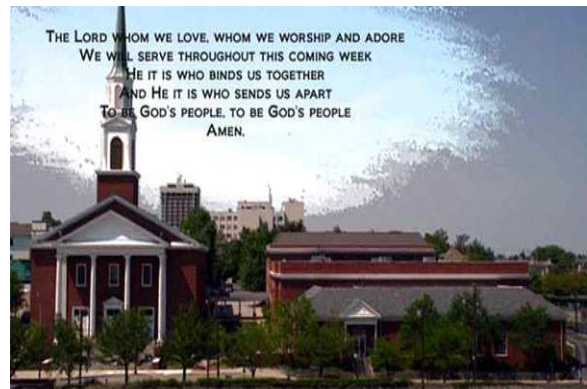
